

Looking for some fun Fall party ideas? Try these...

Chili Bar:

Serve chili in a crockpot with a variety of toppings – cheese, onions, jalapenos and more.

Cheese and Sausage Board:

Serve a variety of hard and soft cheeses and mixed sausages with crackers and breads. Add some mustards and fruit slices as well.

Popcorn Bar:

Serve a big barrel of popcorn with a variety of mix ins – M&M's, chocolate chips and peanuts.

Hot Chocolate Bar:

Keep the hot chocolate in a crockpot, serve with chocolate or butterscotch chips, a variety of flavored marshmallows and cups with a fitted lid.

Trail Mix Bar:

Granola with a variety of dried fruits and berries, nuts, crackers and chips

Apple Cider Bar:

Keep the cider hot in a crockpot, and serve cinnamon sticks, orange slices and caramels, with (your choice!) of liquors on the side.

Caramel Apple Nacho Bar:

Serve plates of sliced apples which can be drizzled with melted caramel, M&M's, nuts and candy corn.

Sangria Bar:

Keep sangria warm in a crockpot and serve with cinnamon sticks, orange slices, apple slices and a variety of flavored schnapps.

Apple Candles:

Trace around a votive candle at the top of your apple, cut out with a knife and melon baller, then add candle and light

Pumpkin Painting:

Set up a covered table with acrylic paints and a variety of pumpkin sizes and colors and let the creativity flow

Pumpkin Ice Bucket:

Hollow out a large'ish pumpkin and fill with ice and a few bottles of your favorite hard ciders

Ice Eye Balls:

Using distilled water, add plastic eye balls into a large ice making tray – when frozen, add to a punch bowl

Firefly Mason Jars:

Fill a Mason jar with acorns, Spanish moss and battery operated LED lights. Put the battery pack on top and screw the lid on.

Gourd Vases:

Use large gourds as vases, cut a hole in the top, scoop out a bit of the insides and add long stem flowers

Candle Holders:

Use a variety of heights of candle holders, but top with small pumpkins and gourds.

Mason Jar Leaf Votives:

Paint the outside of a Mason Jar with Mod Podge, then layer on real (or fake!) autumn leaves. Let dry, tie raffia around the top and add a votive candle.
